MEMBERSHIP

ACTIVITIES

(b) Betta Society Malaysia 2008 Competition

(c) MAHA 2008 Exhibition

(d) Aquafair Malaysia 2008 – International Betta Competition

The event was held from 20th to 23rd November 2008 at Kuala Lumpur Convention Centre. 350 tanks of competition fishes participated at the show. The event was planned, coordinated and organized with assistance of our members successfully.

Good crowd turnout was received together with high turnover during the event.

A charity event was organized for Rumah Anak Yatim Nur Salam Chow Kit.

(e) Betta Sunday for the year 2008

Betta Sunday was successfully organized with alternate places; Chinese Hawker's Center in Jinjang and Slippery Little Suckers (SLS) in Ara Damansara.

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS - 31 DECEMBER 2008

1. PRINCIPLE OBJECTS/ACTIVITIES

(a) Principal Activities

The Society is formed to enhance the appreciation of show bettas and to teach the public that apart from fighting and enjoy their beauty. Along with keeping show bettas, there is beauty in wild bettas as well. There has been no significant change in the nature of these activities during the financial year.

(b) Background and Registered Office

The Society is formed under Registrar of Society and domiciled in Malaysia.

The registered office of the Society is located at Lot 139, Batu 16, Sungai Plong, 47000 Sungai Buloh, Selangor Darul Ehsan.

(c) Principal Place of Business

The principal place and correspondence address of the Society is at No. 43, Jalan 14/36, 46100 Petaling Jaya, Selangor Darul Ehsan.

2. BASIS OF PREPARATION OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

The financial statements of the Society have been prepared in accordance with the applicable approved accounting standards in Malaysia.

3. DATE OF AUTHORISATION OF ISSUE

The financial statements were authorized for issue by the Members in accordance with a resolution of the Members on .

4. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

(a) Basis of Accounting

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention unless statements otherwise.

(b) Property, plant and equipment and depreciation

Property, plant and equipment are stated at cost less accumulated depreciation and impairment losses. The policy for the recognition and measurement of impairment losses is in accordance with Note 4(c).

Depreciation of property, plant and equipment is provided for on a straight-line basis to write off the cost of each asset to its residual value over the estimated useful life, at the following annual rates:

Computer	20%
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Upon disposal of an item of property, plant and equipment, the difference between the net disposal proceeds and the carrying amount is charged or credited to the income statement.

(c) Impairment of assets

At each balance sheet date, the Society reviews the carrying amounts of its assets, to determine whether any indication that those assets have suffered an impairment loss is. If any such indication exists, impairment is measured by comparing the carrying values of the assets with their recoverable amounts. Recoverable amount is the higher of the net selling price and value in use, which is measured by reference to discounted future cash flows. Recoverable amounts are estimated for individual assets or, if it is not possible, for the cash generating unit to which the asset belongs.

An impairment loss is charged to the income statement immediately.

Reversal of impairment losses recognized in prior years is recorded when there is an indication that the impairment losses recognized for the assets no longer exists or have decreased. The reversal is recognized to the extent of the carrying amount of the assets that would have been determined (net of amortization and depreciation) had no impairment loss been recognized. The reversal is recognized in the income statement immediately.

(d) Financial Instruments

Financial instruments are recognised in the balance sheet when the society has become a party to the contractual provisions of the instruments. Financial instruments carried on the balance sheet include cash and bank balances, bank borrowings, receivables, payables and equity instruments.

Financial instruments are classified as liabilities or equity in accordance with the substance of the contractual arrangement. Interest, dividends, gains and losses relating to a financial instrument classified as liability are reported as expense or income. Distributions to holders of financial instruments classified as equity are charged directly to equity. Financial instruments are offset when the Society has a legally enforceable right to offset and intends to settle either on a net basis or to realize the asset and settle the liability simultaneously.

(i) Other non-current investments

Non-current investments other than investments in subsidiaries and associates are stated at cost less provision for any permanent diminution in value. Such provision is made when there is a decline other than temporary in the value of investments and is recognized as an expense in the period in which the decline occurred.

On disposal of an investment, the difference between net disposal proceeds and its carrying amount is charged or credited to the income statement.

(ii) Trade and other receivables

Trade and other receivables are carried at anticipated realizable values. Known bad debts are written off in the period in which they are identified. An estimate is made for doubtful debts based on a review of all outstanding amounts at the end of the financial period when required.

(d) Financial Instruments (Cont'd..)

(iii) Trade and other payables

Trade and other payables as stated at cost, which is the fair value of the consideration to be paid in the future for goods and service received.

(iv) Equity instruments

Ordinary shares are classified as equity. Dividends on ordinary shares are recognized in equity in the period in which they are declared.

(e) Income Recognition

Membership subscription is payable annually at the beginning of the financial year. Only subscription which is attributable to the current financial year is recognized as income. Subscription relating to periods beyond the current financial year is taken up in the Balance Sheet as Subscription in advance. Subscription is payable in full irrespective of the date of resignation of members during the financial year.

Income from Betta Competition is recognized on confirmation of a participant's registration. Income received for such activities that take place after the financial year is taken up as Deferred Income.

Income relating to the sale of goods is recognized at the fair value of the consideration receivable and is recognized when the significant risks and rewards of ownership have been transferred to the buyer.

(f) Cash Flow Statement

The Society adopts the direct method in presentation of cash flow statement.

Cash and cash equivalents comprise cash in hand and at bank.

(g) Subscription In Arrears

Subscription in arrears of 6 months and above due from members who were removed from the Register of Members and where, in the opinion of the Member, these debts are no longer recoverable are written off to the Income Statement. An estimate is made for doubtful debts based on a review of all subscription in arrears at the balance sheet date. Subsequent recovery is taken up on a cash basis. Members who are ongoing investigation and disciplinary proceedings instituted against them and who are in arrears of more than six (6) months will not be removed from the Register of Members.

(h) Inventories

Souvenirs and merchandise items are stated at the lower of cost and net realizable value. Cost is determined on the first-in, first-out. Net realizable value is the estimated selling price in the ordinary course of business less the estimated costs necessary to make the sale.

20. FINANCIAL INSTRUMENTS AND RELATED DISCLOSURES

(a) Financial Risk Management Objectives and Policies

The Society's financial risk management policies seek to ensure that adequate financial resources are available for the development of the Society's business whilst managing its risks. The Society operates within clearly defined guidelines that are approved by the Members and the Society's policy is not to engage in speculative transactions.

The main areas of financial risks faced by the Society and the policy in respect of the major areas of treasury activity are set out as follows:

(i) Credit risk

Credit risks are controlled by the credit authorizations, approvals, limits and monitoring procedures. Credit risks are minimized and monitored via strictly limiting the Society associations to business partners with high creditworthiness. Trade receivables are monitored on an ongoing basis via Society management reporting procedures.

The Society does not have any significant exposure to any individual customer or counterparty nor does it have any major concentration of credit risk related to any financial instruments. The maximum exposure to credit risk is represented by the carrying amount of the financial liability in the balance sheets.

(ii) Interest rate risk

The Society's income and operating cash flows are substantially independent of changes in market interest rate. The exposure to interest rate risk arises mainly from interest-bearing borrowings and short term deposits.

The Society manages its interest rate exposure by maintaining a mix of fixed and floating rate borrowings. The Society reviews its debts portfolio, taking into account the investment holding period and nature of its assets. This strategy allows it to capitalize on cheaper funding in a low interest rate environment and achieve a certain level of protection against rate hikes. The Society also uses hedging instruments such as interest rate swaps to minimized its exposure to interest rate volatility.

(iii) Liquidity and cash flow risk

The Society's exposure to liquidity and cash flow risk arises mainly from general funding, internal source of financing and its business activities.

As part of its prudent liquidity management, the Society maintains sufficient levels of cash equivalents and other source of financing through certain committed credit facility.
